

LONDON BOROUGH OF ISLINGTON**TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT ORDER****2016/153**

RELATING TO: CALEDONIAN ROAD

The Islington (Prescribed Routes) (No. 8) Traffic Order 2016

Made on... 22 December 2016

Coming into force on... 26 December 2016

The Council of the London Borough of Islington, after consulting with the Commissioner of Police of the Metropolis in exercise of the powers conferred by section 6 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), and of all other powers thereunto enabling, hereby make the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as the Islington (Prescribed Routes) (No. 8) Traffic Order 2016, and shall come into force on 26 December 2016.

2. In this Order:

“enactment” means any enactment, whether public general or local, and includes any order, byelaw, rule, regulation, scheme or other instrument having effect by virtue of an enactment and any reference in this Order to any enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended, applied, consolidated, re-enacted by or as having effect by virtue of any subsequent enactment;

"pedal cycle" has the same meaning as in the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2002(b).

"with-flow lane" mean a traffic lane reserved for a specified class of traffic proceeding in the same direction as general traffic in an adjoining traffic lane.

3. Every person, causing any vehicle to proceed into Caledonian Road, from Cottage Road, shall cause that vehicle, on reaching its junction with Caledonian Road, to TURN LEFT into Caledonian Road.

4. Nothing in Articles 3, 4, 5 and 6 of this Order shall apply to:
- (a) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform;
 - (b) any vehicle being used for ambulance, fire brigade or police purposes in an emergency; and
 - (c) any person who causes any vehicle to proceed in accordance with any restriction or requirement indicated by traffic signs placed pursuant to Section 66 or 67 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.
