Request for Information - Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA)

Thank you for your email of the 20 April 2016 where you requested information about penalty tribunal adjudicator's decisions in relation to The Rock.

To ascertain how many PCN cases were heard by the Traffic Penalty Tribunal in relation to The Rock would still exceed £450 or 18 hours of work at £25 per hour. Additionally, due to Data Protection issues I would not provide you with full copies of the Adjudicator decisions.

Section 12 of the Act makes provision for public authorities to refuse requests for information where the cost of dealing with them would exceed the appropriate limit, which for Local Government is set at £450. This represents the estimated cost of one person spending 18 hours at £25 per hour in determining whether the Council holds the information i.e. in locating, retrieving and extracting the information.

However, the non-archived Tribunal cases that are retained in Parking Services show that:

There were 5 PCN's appealed for The Rock at the Traffic Penalty Tribunal.

There were 2 appeals dismissed

There were 2 appeals allowed

There is 1 case awaiting a decision.

If you are dissatisfied with the handling of your request, you have the right to ask for an internal review. Internal review requests should be submitted within two months of the date of receipt of the response to your original letter and should be addressed to:
