### **Freedom of Information Act 2000**

I can confirm that Warwickshire County Council holds the information you requested. However we are withholding that information since we consider that the following exemptions apply to it.

- If the TRO is permanent, seasonal or temporary.**
- If temporary or seasonal, details for the dates when they are open and closed**
- Any other details that might be relevant to vehicular users.**
