Dear Requester

Thank you for your request for information dated 12/05/2021 about surveys of road traffic. We have dealt with this under the Freedom of Information Act 2000.

Response

Can you please list all surveys of road traffic conducted by automatic counters on any road in N6, since I last requested the data 2016?

Please state the location for each, the period covered, the company that conducted the survey, and any other readily available information.

Please supply the full data that is available, for example speed and vehicle weight.

We are refusing your request under section 12 on cost grounds because we estimate that compliance with your request will exceed the "appropriate limit". This is £450 which is equivalent to 18 hours at £25 per hour. The per hour figure is set by Regulations rather than actual salary paid to any officers handling requests. The appropriate limit includes the time it will take the council to discover if it holds the information requested, to locate it, extract it and collate it as well as putting it into any particular format requested by the requester.

We have calculated that it will take approximately 30 hours to comply with your request. We have at least 30 spread sheets of data across the various schemes. If it took at least 1 hour per spread sheet to extract all the information into the format that you have requested, then it would take at least 30 hours to provide all the information.
