Thank you for your email of 17 July 2019, in which you requested the following information:

'I notice that you haven't published any spending data since February 2019.

I'd like to make a request under the Freedom of Information act for all transactions over £25,000 from March 2019 to a month in arrears from the date at which you publish in response to this request.

Please provide the data in a machine readable format (preferably csv). As a minimum, please make sure to include the date, value and recipient of each transaction. Please also provide details on the procurement category of each transaction if you have it.'

I have processed your request under the terms of the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA).

I confirm that we hold the information you have requested. However, under section 21 of the FOIA, we are not required to provide information in response to a request if it is reasonably accessible to you by other means¹.
