Dear Paul Temple

I am writing in response to your Freedom of Information request which was received by ScotRail Trains Limited (SRT) on 26/04/2022. As SRT is a Scottish Public Authority, your request is subject to the terms of the Freedom of Information (Scotland) Act 2002 (FOISA).

## Your request

I write to make a FOI request to request all correspondence between yourselves and Scottish Government and agencies concerning any proposals for free rail travel under 22 year olds.

## **Response to your request**

SRT is applying the following exemption as there has been no correspondence concerning any proposals for free rail travel for under 22 year olds.

ScotRail Trains does not hold the information that you have requested and is not aware of any other public authority that could respond to your request. Section 17 of FOISA states that where public authorities receive requests for information that they do not hold, they must issue a notice advising that they do not hold the requested information. This letter should be treated as formal notice.

## Your right to request a review

Should you be dissatisfied with the way in which the SRT has dealt with your request, you have the right to require us to review our actions and decisions. If you wish to request a review, please contact FOI, ScotRail Trains, Atrium Court, 50 Waterloo Street, Glasgow, G2 6HQ or e-mail: foi@scotrail.co.uk within 40 working days. Your request must be in a recordable format (letter, email, etc). You will receive a full response to your request for review within 20 working days of its receipt.

If you are dissatisfied with the way in which we have handled your request for review you may ask the Scottish Information Commissioner to review our decision.
