57.TRIANGLE FIELD - PRIORY ROAD, HUNGERFORD

Consideration was given to leasing the area of land known as Triangle Field, Hungerford to the Town Council for recreation purposes.

RESOLVED that a further report on the financial aspects of the proposal be made to the Committee.

58.TERMS OF REFERENCE - DELEGATION

A review had taken place of each Committee's terms of reference and scheme of delegation in order to incorporate changes made in the Committee structure and by the introduction of new legislation. The only alteration to the present terms of reference for the Recreation and Amenities Committee was the inclusion of the authority to administer grants under the provisions of Sections 141 and 145 of the Local Government Act 1972. It was suggested that the financial limit on the granting of easements be increased to \5,000 and expressed by reference to a level to enable a periodic review to take place of this and other financial limits.

RESOLVED that the terms of reference and scheme of delegation appended to the Chief Officers report and the increase in the financial limit for granting easements be approved and submitted to the Policy and Resources Committee.

59.DOWNLANDS SPORTS CENTRE JOINT MANAGEMENT COMMITTEE - APPOINTMENT OF REPRESENTATIVE

The Committee considered appointing a representative to the above-mentioned Committee to replace P. Radford who had resigned.

RESOLVED that A.D. Steel be appointed to the Downlands Sports Centre Joint Management Committee for the remainder of Mr. Radford's term of office which expires in May 1991.

60.PROPOSED FOOTWAY AT SCHOOL GREEN, GREENHAM COMMON

The County Council's proposal to surface a footway across School Green at Greenham Common was considered in the light of opposition from local residents and the Crookham and Greenham Commons Advisory Committee.

RESOLVED that the County Council be advised that this Council is opposed to the proposal to surface the footway across School Green, Greenham.
