Dear Ms Pasteur,

Thank you for your email of 16th June 2016 where you requested the following information from the Department of Energy and Climate Change:

To share the outcome report of this project (Cyber Security: Product Assurance Scoping Work) which was commissioned by Thales recently on behalf of DECC.

Under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 ('the Act'), you have the right to:

- know whether we hold the information you require
- be provided with that information (subject to any exemptions under the Act which may apply).

We can confirm that the Department holds the information you have requested. The information you requested is attached.

Some information constitutes personal data and has been withheld. Section 40(2) of the Act provides an absolute exemption for personal data which then falls to be dealt with under the Data Protection Act. Personal data of third parties can only be disclosed in accordance with the data protection principles. In particular, the first data protection principle requires that disclosure must be fair and lawful and must comply with one of the conditions in Schedule 2 of the Data Protection Act. We do not think that it is fair to release the names of third parties and do not think that any of the relevant conditions apply.

Appeals Procedure

If you are dissatisfied with the handling of your request, you have the right to ask for an internal review. Internal review requests should be submitted within 40 working days of the date of receipt of the response to your original letter and should be sent to the Information Rights Unit at:
