REQUEST FOR INFORMATION – *Information relating to Turner Gallery Plymouth Road Penarth*

Thank you for your request for information. As Museum Secretary for Amgueddfa Cymru - National Museum Wales ('the Museum'), I am responsible for responding to your request for information.

I refer to your two emails of 15 August 2015, and your clarifying email of 23 August 2015 in which you asked for information held within our records regarding the administrative history of Turner Gallery:
