I can confirm that the information requested is held by Central Bedfordshire Council. I have detailed below the information that is being released to you.

***Under the Freedom of Information Act I request the following information:***

***Q1. How many Town and Village Green (TVG) applications has this local authority (LA) dealt with since 19 July 2006. Or if this not possible to obtain then the best you can do, but please specify the period of the search.***

A1. Since we took over the role in 2016 we have received one application to add a village green to the register. This is nearing completion after a public inquiry.

***Q2. Of these TVG applications returned in 1, for how many was the Planning Inspectorate's opinion that the TVG application was excluded? In other words that a trigger event had occurred with no closing event.***

***Q3. Of these TVG applications returned in 2, for how many did the processing of the TVG application continue, in other words the LA ignored the Planning Inspectorate's opinion that any TVG application was excluded.***
