"The latest data you see on the website is end of cycle data, which at the moment is 2011. 2011 refers to the year of entry into University."

"Deferred applicants appear in UCAS statistics only in the year in which they apply. Therefore an applicant who is accepted in 2011 for deferred entry in 2012 appears in the data for 2011 entry only."

They also state on their website that their figures are for UK Applicants only so we have shown figures for All Fee Regions and, to mirror the UCAS figures, Home applicants.
