Sanction Levels

A higher level sanction applies where a claimant:

- Fails for no good reason to apply for a particular vacancy
- Fails for no good reason to take up an offer of paid work
- By reason of misconduct or voluntarily and for no good reason ceases paid work
- By reason of misconduct or voluntarily and for no good reason loses pay

A medium level sanction applies where a claimant:

- Fails for no good reason to undertake all reasonable work search action
- Fails for no good reason to be able and willing to take up work

A low level sanction applies where the claimant:

- Fails for no good reason to undertake particular, specified work search action*
- Fails for no good reason to comply with a work preparation requirement
- Fails for no good reason to comply with an interview requirement (this includes self employed claimants who fail to attend an interview during the start up period)
- Fails for no good reason to comply with a requirement to provide evidence or confirm compliance
- Fails for no good reason to comply with a requirement to report any specified changes in their circumstances relevant to work related requirements (at present this will only apply to failure to report a loss of a job within 5 days)

These failures are subject to higher level sanctions.
