**Freedom of Information request (our reference: 50319)**

I am writing in response to your e-mail dated 24 January, which has been handled as an internal review (Time Complaint) in respect of your request for information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA) dated 24 September 2018.

I have now completed the review; Section 10(1) of the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA) requires that the Home Office should have informed you whether the information you requested was held, and if appropriate, have provided it to you within 20 working days of your request being received. Section 10(3) of the FOIA requires that the Home Office should have informed you within this 20 working day period if additional time was required to consider the public interest considerations affecting the information you have requested. Our records show that of the latter of these actions had been carried out in this instance, but regrettably the revised target date was not met either.

I would like to apologise on behalf of the Department for the length of time which it is taking to provide you with a substantive response to your request and for the delay in responding to your initial Time Complaint. The policy area has been informed of your concerns and I can confirm that your request remains under active consideration. Whilst I cannot provide a precise date as to when you will receive a response, the policy area will reply just as soon as it possibly can.

I can understand your frustration over the continuing delay; your patience is very much appreciated.
