### Request

On or about 9th February, 2021, the ICO press office made this statement to the BBC:

"This payment is currently subject to an internal investigation,"

"We believe that the transaction has been made contrary to ICO policies."

"The ICO is committed to upholding high standards in all aspects of our financial management and controls.

"Should a contravention of our finance policies be confirmed, we will take appropriate action, including ensuring the payment is reimbursed."

Accordingly, please disclose the following by way of the Freedom of Information Act, 2000.

- 1. The policies that were suspected to have been breached. as at the date of the press release.
- 2. A copy of the relevant policy document(s).
- 3. Which officer(s) within the ICO, by job title, made the commitment 'to upholding high standards in all aspects of our financial management and controls'?
- 4. (i) Was a contravention of finance policies confirmed? (ii) If so, when was reimbursement made by the officer(s) concerned in the payment to Hotel Chocolat?



- 5. Whom, by job title, commissioned the investigation and whom, by job title(s), carried out the investigation?
- 6. When did the investigation commence, when was it completed and to whom was the investigation outcome delivered?
- 7. Was any external oversight of the investigation provided? If so, by which organisation?
- 8. Was the matter ever reported to the police?

Your request has been handled under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (the FOIA). As you are probably aware, this legislation provides public access to recorded information held by a public authority unless an appropriate exemption applies.

## **Our response**

We do hold information within the scope of your request:

- 1. The policies in question were the ICO Staff Recognition Policy, Corporate Charge Card and Procurement Policies.
- 2. Attached.
- 3. This is not attributed to any member of staff, it was a statement made about the ICO's commitment as an organisation to upholding these standards.
- 4. (i) The investigation confirmed that the transaction was carried out in contravention of ICO policies.
- (i) Given that the transaction was not challenged due to some failures in the oversight of our strict financial controls, we have decided that it would not be appropriate to require any individual budget holder to reimburse the funds.
- 5. Paul Arnold, Chief Operating Officer, commissioned the investigation that was carried out by Forbes solicitors.
- 6. The internal investigation began and was completed in February 2021. Towards the end of February, an external investigation was commissioned by Paul Arnold. The investigation was concluded in late September 2021. The outcome was delivered to Paul Arnold.
- 7. The external investigation was carried out by Forbes Solicitors.
- 8. The police were not contacted, as there was never any evidence of fraud.



# **FOI** review procedure
