Universal Job-match Management Information

You may know that Monster Worldwide Ltd will be delivering the Universal Jobmatch Automated Delivery Service on behalf of DWP from November 2012.

The system will provide an effective automated vacancy matching service to all employers, and people looking for work not just those claiming a benefit or working with Jobcentre Plus.

The service will replace several of the legacy Labour Market and Employment systems. One of the main changes will be that the employer/vacancy functionality will no longer be available in LMS and consequently this will affect the way in which Management Information is sourced and used.

Existing MI Systems that provide Employer information will eventually be de commissioned for example EBAMI and, we are working with CIT to make the necessary arrangements for this. We will also be making arrangements to de commission LMS MIS and BIS reports that contain vacancy, submission and employer information following full consultation with the report owners

Existing vacancy data feeds to NOMIS which are LMS based will cease following the de commission of the LMS vacancy functionality.

Live employer records and live vacancy information will be migrated from LMS to Universal Jobmatch over the weekend before go live.

Monster will be providing Management Information based on requirements agreed with DWP stakeholders. There will be

- a suite of internal pre-defined reports available to DWP users. Access to these reports will be via an icon that will appear on your desktop when the service goes live. The suite will consist of reports about Employers, Jobseekers and Vacancies
- a suite of external reports available to everyone with access to the Internet. These will consist of reports about Employers, Jobseekers and Vacancies and will be available in English and Welsh
- Web Analytics MI available to a limited number of users
- Ad hoc reporting tools for MI, Audit and Analytical MI available to defined users

Users will have access to the report functions dependant on their job roles and this will determine the appropriate access levels. All DWP data security standards will apply when handling Universal Jobmatch MI.

Learning and Development products and guidance are being developed and should be available in the next couple of weeks on the intranet .

Look out for an MI Bulletin Special on Universal Jobmatch MI in week commencing 5th November in which we will provide much more detail.
