

Universal Jobmatch: Employer Initiatives

Background

If a company has either expressed an interest or is already engaged in an Employer Initiative, it should be possible for Employer Facing staff to associate that company with the Initiative on Universal Jobmatch, however, the list Initiatives is not yet available, as it is still subject to final agreement by the Employer Virtual Team (made up of employer policy representatives).

Action

The following work around should be adopted prior to the final list being agreed and included on Universal Jobmatch:

Employer Facing Staff should include details of 'Initiatives' that companies have either expressed an interest or are already engaged in, within the general 'Notes' field of the company's Universal Jobmatch account.

Employer Initiatives include the following (this list is not exhaustive and will be subject to final agreement):

- Enterprise Clubs (GBW)
- New Enterprise Allowance (GBW)
- sector based work academies (GBW)
- Work Clubs (GBW)
- work experience opportunity (GBW)
- Work Together (GBW)
- Work Trials
- Youth Contract

It is hoped that the agreed list of Employer Initiatives will be added during December 2012.

Once agreed, Employer Facing Staff will be able to select the appropriate Employer Initiative from the list held within Universal Jobmatch.
