Report of the Joint Selection Committee of Representatives of the Council and Senate for the appointment of Vice-Chancellor

- 1. It was agreed that approval be given to the filling of the role of Vice-Chancellor. A Joint Panel was established under the Chairmanship of Mr. David McDonnell, President of Council; and Sir Martin Harris, Deputy Chairman, Northwest Regional Development Agency, agreed to act as External Adviser.
- 2. The role was advertised and in response to the advertisement 34 applications were received (33 males, 1 female). Following further consultations between members of the Joint Panel, it was agreed that one applicant should be invited to meet the Panel.
- 3. The applicant met the Panel on 27 June 2007. Comments were available from the External Adviser, Sir Martin Harris.
- 4. At the conclusion of the interview, it was agreed that Sir Howard Newby should be appointed to the role of Vice-Chancellor.
- 5. The Joint Panel has therefore agreed to recommend:-

That Sir Howard Newby, KB CBE BA PhD AcSS FRSA, be appointed to the role of Vice-Chancellor from 1 September 2008, on the appropriate terms and conditions for an appointment to the role of Vice-Chancellor.
