Thank you for your email of 28 July 2015, in which you asked for the following information from the Ministry of Justice (MoJ) in relation to Tameside Magistrates' Court:

How many utility power of entry warrants were issued to energy companies or their agents for subject property addresses with: BB; BL; OL; M; SK; WA; and WN postal codes prefixes, in March 2015?
