Dear Ms Burton

I refer to your request under the Freedom of Information Act Ref 235/14 dated 16th April 2014, requesting information on vehicles owned / leased by Bassetlaw District Council.

Whilst the Act confers a general right of access to information held by public authorities, Section 1 provides that any person making a request for information to a public authority is entitled:-

- a) To be informed in writing by the public authority whether it holds information of the description specified in the request; and
- b) If that is the case to have that information communicated to him', subject to the effect of the exemptions in Part 11 of the Act.

Therefore pursuant to the Council's duty to confirm or deny whether or not it holds the information requested I can confirm the following:-

1. A list of vehicles owned or leased to the Council. Please include; registration mark, fleet number (if used), make & model and body type.

Please find attached an excel spreadsheet detailing this information.

2. Of the vehicles leased, a list of the companies from which the vehicles are leased. Vehicles are leased through SG Equipment and Crystal.
3. Name, position and email address of the staff responsible for these vehicles. All vehicles owned / leased by the Authority are the responsibility of the Principal Operations Services Manager. His contact details are:-

4. If your refuse collection is outsourced please provide the name of the company responsible and a list of the vehicles used for this purpose including vehicle registration mark, fleet number (if used), make & model and body type.
