DUDLEY METROPOLITAN BOROUGH COUNCIL

(VELO BIRMINGHAM & MIDLANDS) (TRAFFIC REGULATION) (SPECIAL EVENT) ORDER 2019

WHEREAS the Dudley Metropolitan Borough Council (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") being the Highway Authority for Dudley is satisfied that vehicular, pedestrians, horse riders, horses and non-event cyclist traffic should be prohibited and restricted on the roads specified in the Schedules attached hereto to facilitate the holding of the event.

NOW THEREFORE the Council in exercise of its powers under S.16A of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended by Section 1 of the Road Traffic (Special Events) Act 1994 (hereinafter referred to as "the Act") and all other enabling powers and with the consent of the English Government hereby make the following Order prohibiting and restricting the use of certain roads and road junctions by vehicles, pedestrians, horse riders, horses and non-event cyclists to facilitate the holding of the Velo Birmingham & Midlands 2019 on Sunday 12th May 2019.

The Order shall come into operation on 12th May 2019 and may be cited as the Dudley Metropolitan Borough Council (Velo Birmingham & Midlands) (Traffic Regulation) (Special Event) Order 2019.

In this Order, the following expressions have the meanings hereby respectively assigned to them:-

"Relevant Event" means the Velo Birmingham & Midlands 2019.

"Council" means Dudley Metropolitan Borough Council.

"Act" means the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended by Section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1994.

"Designated Officer" means an Officer appointed by the Council in respect of traffic management of the Birmingham Velo 2017.

"Motor Vehicle" means a mechanically propelled vehicle intended or adapted for use on roads as set out in Section 136 (1) of the Act.

"Motor Cycle" means a mechanically propelled vehicle, as defined in Section 185 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1988.

"Police Vehicle" has the same meaning as in the TSRGD.

"Bus" has the same meaning as in Schedule 1 of Regulation 2 of the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016 (SI 2016.362) – TSRGD.

"Public Service Vehicle" means a vehicle as defined in Section 1 of the Public Passenger Vehicles Act 1981.

"Disabled Person's Parking Badge" means a badge issued in accordance with the Disabled Persons (Badges for Motor Vehicles) (ENGLAND) (Regulations 2000 as amended) or a similar badge issued by another country within the European Unions.

"Universal Service Provider" has the same meaning as that assigned to it in Section 4 (3) of the Postal Services Act 2000.

- No person shall cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed along the lengths of road specified in Schedules to this Order or any parts thereof (including junctions linking the said roads unless otherwise indicated) between the hours specified in the Schedules to the Order on Sunday 12th May 2019.
- 2. Any vehicle deemed to be hindering the passage of the race, causing a nuisance and / or obstruction on the roads; or road junctions specified in the Schedules to this Order shall be authorised by the Council to be removed.
- 3. Nothing in Article 1 of this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed along the lengths of road to which those Articles apply if it is necessary to do so to enable:
 - i. any vehicle being used in connection with the relevant event including those used for stewarding, crowd management and traffic management purposes or
 - ii. any vehicle officially accredited to the relevant event and which displays the appropriate accreditation operating in connection with the relevant event, or
- iii. any vehicle being used on the direction of or with the permission of a police constable in uniform or a traffic marshal, designated officer or any other official so authorised in the control and operation of the relevant event or in accordance with any sign placed by the Council or approved traffic management specialist acting on behalf of the event organiser, or
- iv. any vehicle being used in connection with the relevant event by a designated officer.
- v. any vehicle being used for the removal of any vehicle deemed to be hindering the passage of the race, causing a nuisance and / or obstruction on the roads or road junctions, specified in the Schedules to this Order, or
- vi. the vehicle to be used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes in cases of emergency, or
- vii. the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in pursuance of statutory powers or duties or in connection with any building operation or demolition, the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the road or the laying, erection, alteration or repair in, or in land adjacent to the road of any sewer or of any main, pipe, wire or cable or any apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of any electronic communications apparatus as defined in Schedule 2 to the Telecommunications Act 1984.
- 4. Save as provided in Article 3, except upon the direction of or with the permission of a Police Constable, Police Community Support Officer, designated officer, event organiser or any person in connection with the relevant event, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle or bus to stop or wait, including waiting for the purpose of loading and unloading goods in the lengths of road or on any verges specified in the Schedules to this Order during the hours specified in the Schedule to this Order on Sunday 12th May 2019.

- 5. Save as provided in Article 3, except upon the direction of or with the permission of a Police Constable, Police Community Support Officer, designated officer, event organiser or any person in connection with the relevant event, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle or bus to stop or wait to enable a person to board or alight from a vehicle in the lengths of road or on any verges specified in the Schedules to this Order during the hours specified in this Order on Sunday 12th May 2019.
- 6. Save as provided in Article 3, except upon the direction of or with the permission of a Police Constable, Police Community Support Officer, designated officer, event organiser or any person in connection with the relevant event, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle being used by a Universal Service Provider to enter or proceed, stop or wait in the lengths of road or on any verges specified in the Schedules to this Order during the hours specified in this Order on Sunday 12th September 2019.

7. TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF STOPPING

Save as provided in Article 3, except upon the direction of or with the permission of a Police Constable, Police Community Support Officer, designated officer, event organiser or any person in connection with the relevant event, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to stop in the lengths of road or on any verges specified in Schedule 2 to this Order during the hours of 8:00am and 7:00pm on Sunday 12th May 2019.

8. <u>TEMPORARY SUSPENSION OF EXISTING DISABLED PERSONS PARKING PLACES (DPPP'S)</u>

Save as provided in Article 3, except upon the direction of or with the permission of a Police Constable, Police Community Support Officer, designated officer, event organiser or any person in connection with the relevant event, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle being used for the conveyance of a disabled person and has displayed in a conspicuous position a disabled persons badge to wait on the roads or sides of roads or an any verges specified in the Schedules to this Order during the hours of 8:00am and 7:00pm on Sunday 12th May 2019.

- 9. Save as provided in Article 3, except upon the direction of or with the permission of a Police Constable, Police Community Support Officer, designated officer, event organiser or any person in connection with the relevant event, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle being used for the conveyance of a disabled person and has displayed in a conspicuous position a disabled persons badge to park within a parking bay marked as only available for a disabled persons vehicle on any of the roads identified in the Schedules to this Order during the hours specified in the Schedules to this Order on Sunday 12th May 2019.
- 10. Except upon the direction of a Police Constable, Police Community Support Officer, designated officer, event organiser or any person in connection with the relevant event, no exemptions will apply for disabled persons vehicles on any of the roads specified in the Schedules to this Order during the hours specified in the Schedules to this Order for the duration of the Order.
- 11. The Interpretation Act 1889 shall apply to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
- 12. The Council are satisfied that, in order to avoid danger to persons or other traffic using the roads to which this Order relates, or for preventing the likelihood of any such danger arising, or for facilitating the passage of the vehicular traffic on the roads, vehicular access to premises situated in the Schedules to this Order or

- accessible only therefrom may be restricted for the duration of the Order save as provided in Article 3 of this Order.
- 13. The Council are also satisfied, in accordance with Section 16A (3) of the Act, that the event to which this Order relates cannot be held otherwise than on a road. Such is the length of the route and the nature of the closure, the Council does not consider it practical to recommend alternative routes for traffic.
- 14. Access for pedestrians to premises situated on or adjacent to any road to which the Order relates will not be prevented.

STATEMENT OF REASONS FOR PROPOSING TO MAKE THE ORDER

Velo Birmingham & Midlands is a mass cycling event of 15,000 cyclists, taking part over a 100 mile route on completely closed roads. The route starts in Birmingham, then passes through Dudley and Sandwell into Worcestershire and Staffordshire, returning to finish in Birmingham.

In order to safely facilitate the event it will be necessary to close some main roads and side roads throughout Dudley's highway network on Sunday 12th May 2019, from 8am until 7pm, which is when the event will be taking place within Dudley. The closures are necessary, not only for the safety of the participants but for the safety of the public and also for enabling essential race infrastructure to be built and highway signage to be erected.

Due to the size of the event and the sheer number of cyclists taking part, the race route and many other approach and adjoining side roads will need to be kept entirely traffic free, including parked vehicles.

For reasons of safety and security, any vehicle deemed to be hindering the passage of the race, causing a nuisance and/or obstruction on the roads, road junctions or verges specified in the Schedules to the Order shall be authorised by the Council to be removed.

As traffic authority for Dudley Metropolitan Borough Council and with the consent of the English Government an Order under S.16A of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as

amended) is to be made by Dudley Metropolitan Borough Council prohibiting and restricting the use of certain roads and road junctions by vehicles, pedestrians, horse riders, horses and non-event cyclists to safely facilitate the holding of the Dudley section of the Velo Birmingham & Midlands 2019, in the interests of both the event itself and public safety.

Prohibit all persons, on foot or by any other means (including cyclists and those riding, leading or driving horses or other animals) from entering or proceeding in those parts of the footpath (FP) and byway (BY), specified in reference schedule of roads) to the extent indicated, (exemptions will apply for emergency access and for persons acting with the authority of a police constable in uniform or a steward).



A key next step in the RTCC programme is to run a pilot RTCC as a proof of concept to validate the CONOPs and to start to inform the RTCC Detailed Operations Plans (DOPs) that will set out **HOW** the RTCC will operate.

A pilot RTCC will be mobilised to support three events in the early summer:

- Birmingham Velo (and Take That at the Birmingham Arena),
- · Cricket World Cup fixtures,
- Five Ways Underpass Closure.

in relation to the staging of an annual closed roads mass participation cycling event in the West Midlands in 2019 (the "Event(s)").

Under separate contractual arrangements through Birmingham City Council, CSM have been engaged to stage the Events.

The Partner wishes to support such Events on the terms and conditions set out in this LOA.

The parties agree as follows:

1. Term: This LOA shall take effect when it is signed and dated by both Parties and shall continue until 1 June 2019, unless terminated in accordance with clause 8 (the "Term").

2. CSM's Obligations

2.1. CSM shall:

- 2.1.1. be primarily responsible for the organisation, staging, safety and image of the Events:
- 2.1.2. make all strategic decisions relating to the Events and consult regularly with the Partner in relation to the Events;
- 2.1.3. consult with all relevant authorities within Dudley in relation to the staging of the Events (including, without limitation, the police, parking control and traffic management);
- 2.1.4. maintain at its own expense comprehensive third party public liability insurance from a reputable insurance company with cover to the value of at least £10m to protect against any and all claims, actions, personal injuries, losses and damages arising under this LOA;

- 2.1.5. as between CSM and the Partner, be responsible for and retain all commercial rights to each Events (including, without limitation, sponsorship, broadcast, other media, partnerships and entries), and shall be freely entitled to enter into such agreements;
- 2.1.6. procure branding exposure for the Partner in relation to the Events (such as advertising, Event website and promotional materials); and
- 2.1.7. provide the Partner with twenty five (25) General Entry places for each Event (free of charge but not for resale; usage must comply with the relevant Event participation terms and all applicable laws relating to data protection and promotions).
- 2.2. For the avoidance of doubt, CSM shall be under no obligation to stage the Events within Dudley if, in CSM's reasonable opinion, it would not be viable to do so.

3. Partner Obligations:

3.1. The Partner shall:

- 3.1.1. provide reasonable support and assistance to CSM (and, where required, Birmingham City Council) with the organistation, staging, safety and image of the Events within Dudley (including, without limitation, the planning of the Event routes, traffic management planning, arranging necessary approvals, community and business communications, pro-actively promoting and publicising the Events, and any other activity required in facilitating the smooth running of the Events);
- 3.1.2. procure at no cost, full road closures required for the Events within Dudley (it being acknowledged that, as at the date of this LOA, the road closures and timings required for the 2019 Event are set out in Appendix 1);
- 3.1.3. provide and procure reasonable support and cooperation in respect of all relevant authorities within Dudley in the staging of the Events (including, without limitation, the police, parking control and traffic management);
- 3.1.4. cooperate and provide reasonable access and assistance to CSM (and, where required, Birmingham City Council) and any third party Event partners;
- 3.1.5. where appropriate, make introductions to potential commercial partners for the Events in the Dudley business community;
- 3.1.6. procure that there is no Partner supported mass participation event involving road closures within Dudley for the period of one month either side of each annual iteration of the Event; and
- 3.1.7. not knowingly and/or intentionally do or permit anything to be done which might adversely affect the rights of each of CSM or Birmingham City Council, or any of the commercial rights associated with the Events (or the value of such rights), and shall provide reasonable assistance to CSM (and, where required, Birmingham City Council) in relation to the protection and use of such rights.
- 3.1.8. undertake and provide the Traffic Management (including the provision of its own staff) of the Event(s) within the Borough of Dudley for and on behalf of CSM in respect of the Route more particularly set out at Appendix 1 for which the Partner shall charge CSM a maximum of £2500.

4. Costs



- 4.1. With the exception of clause 3.1.8 above any staff costs (including, without limitation, officer time, costs and expenses) incurred by the Partner in relation to this LOA shall be borne by the Partner.
- 4.2. Any additional costs incurred by the Partner may be reimbursed by CSM provided in all cases that CSM has approved the Partner incurring such itemised costs in advance in writing.

5. Intellectual Property:

- 5.1. No party shall acquire any interest in any Intellectual Property of another party, except as expressly provided in this LOA.
- 5.2. Each party hereby grants the other party, a worldwide, non-exclusive, royalty-free, non-transferable, licence for the Term to use its Intellectual Property in connection with this LOA solely for purposes of enabling each party to exploit its rights and comply with its obligations under this LOA.

6. Confidentiality

- 6.1. Each party shall use the confidential information of the other party only for the proper performance of its duties under this LOA and shall not without the disclosing party's written consent disclose or permit the disclosure of the confidential information except in confidence for the proper performance of its duties under this LOA to those of its employees, officers and professional advisers who need to have access to it.
- 6.2. The provisions of clause 6.1 shall not apply to confidential information which (i) was known to the receiving party before receipt, (ii) is in or enters the public domain through no wrongful default by or on behalf of the receiving party or (iii) was received from a third party without similar obligations of confidence or (iv) if required to be disclosed by law, including the Freedom of Information Act 2000 or the Environmental Information Regulations 2004.
- 6.3. The provisions of this clause 6 shall survive any termination or expiry of this LOA.
- 7. Communications: The text of any press release or communication concerning the Events and/or the partnership between CSM, Birmingham City Council and the Partner shall, unless it is otherwise agreed, be subject to CSM's prior written approval. CSM agrees to share any significant press releases to the Partner, in order for Partner to comment on the content of such press releases, in advance of public distribution (subject to any urgent statements) and where possible will incorporate Partner's requests in relation to such press release.

8. Termination

- 8.1. Either CSM or the Partner may terminate this LOA upon giving thirty (30) days' written notice if the other is in material breach of any term or condition of this LOA and has falled (in the case of a breach capable of being remedied) to remedy the breach within fourteen (14) days of a written request to do so.
- 8.2. CSM may terminate this LOA immediately upon giving written notice: (a) within sixty (60) days after the staging of each Event; or (b) if CSM ceases to have the right to stage the Events (for any reason).
- 8.3. The termination of this LOA for any reason shall not affect those provisions expressly or implicitly having effect after termination and, in the case of termination pursuant to clause 8.1, shall be without prejudice to any other right or remedy of any party in respect of the breach concerned (if any) or any other breach.

9. Llability

- 9.1. Nothing in this LOA shall limit the liability of any party for death or personal injury resulting from its negligence or for fraudulent misrepresentation or for any liability which cannot be excluded by law.
- 9.2. No party to this LOA shall be liable to another party for any indirect or consequential loss.
- 9.3. Except as stated in clause 9.1, the aggregate liability of each party to the other party with respect to all claims under or in connection with this LOA shall be limited to damages not exceeding £500,000.

10. Warranties:

10.1. Each party warrants and undertakes to the other that:



- 10.1.1. it has full power and authority to enter into this LOA; and
- 10.1.2. It shall not, in entering into this LOA or in performing its obligations hereunder be in breach of, or be prevented or delayed in the fulfilment of its obligations by:
 - 10.1.2.1. any provision of its constitutional documents;
 - 10.1.2.2. any contractual or other obligation owed by it to any other person; or
 - 10.1.2.3. any laws or regulations in its jurisdiction of incorporation or any order, decree or judgment of any court or any governmental entity;
- 10.1.3. in the performance of its obligations hereunder and for the duration of the Term, it shall comply with:
 - 10.1.3.1. the UK Data Protection Act 2018 and the General Data Protection Regulation (EU2016/679) (and any replacement act thereof) and all other applicable laws, regulations, codes and sanctions relating to data privacy and information security;
 - 10.1.3.2. the UK Bribery 2010 and all other applicable laws, regulations, codes and sanctions relating to anti-bribery and anti-corruption;
 - 10.1.3.3. any trade, export controls, economic or financial sanctions laws, regulations, embargoes or restrictive measures administered, enacted or enforced by the authorities of the United Kingdom;
 - 10.1.3.4. the Modern Slavery Act 2015 and all other applicable laws, regulations, codes and sanctions relating to anti-slavery and human trafficking.

11. General

- 11.1. This LOA is intended to be legally binding upon the parties.
- 11.2. This LOA, or any provision thereof, may be amended or modified only with the mutual consent of the parties as set out in writing, signed by an authorised representative, and expressly stating the parties' intent to amend this LOA.
- 11.3. All notices between the parties with respect to this LOA shall be in writing and signed by or on behalf of the party giving it. Any notice shall be duly served; (i) on delivery if delivered by hand; (ii) 48 hours after sending if sent by first class post or recorded delivery; or (iii) on sending if sent by email (provided that a copy is also sent by post in accordance with (ii) above), provided that in each case: (a) the notice is sent to the address of the addressee in this LOA (or such other address as the addressee may from time to time have notified for the purpose of this clause); and (b) in relation to notices served on CSM, a copy of such notice is also sent by email to: csm.legal@csm.com.
- 11.4. The Parties record that in the interests of good relations between them they will endeavour to resolve any issue of dispute between them before resorting to litigation but this will not oblige an aggrieved party to attempt to resolve any issue amicably or by negotiating if it has formed the view that this is not likely to be achievable.
- 11.5. This LOA and any dispute or claim arising out of or in connection therewith (including any non-contractual claim or dispute) shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of England and Wales. Each party submits to the exclusive jurisdiction of the English courts.

All warranties and undertakings shall, unless otherwise expressly stated, continue in full force and effect during the Term.





STATEMENT OF REASONS FOR PROPOSING TO MAKE THE ORDER

Velo Birmingham & Midlands is a mass cycling event of 15,000 cyclists, taking part over a 100 mile route on completely closed roads. The route starts in Birmingham, then passes through Warwickshire, Coventry, Solihull, Birmingham, Dudley and returning to finish in Birmingham.

In order to safely facilitate the event it will be necessary to close some main roads and side roads throughout Dudley's highway network on Sunday 12th May 2019, from 8.15am until 7pm, which is when the event will be taking place within Dudley. The closures are necessary, not only for the safety of the participants but for the safety of the public and also for enabling essential race infrastructure to be built and highway signage to be erected.

Due to the size of the event and the sheer number of cyclists taking part, the race route and many other approach and adjoining side roads will need to be kept entirely traffic free, including parked vehicles.

For reasons of safety and security, any vehicle deemed to be hindering the passage of the race, causing a nuisance and/or obstruction on the roads, road junctions or verges specified in the Schedules to the Order shall be authorised by the Council to be removed.

As traffic authority for Dudley Metropolitan Borough Council and with the consent of the English Government an Order under S.16A of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as

amended) is to be made by Dudley Metropolitan Borough Council prohibiting and restricting the use of certain roads and road junctions by vehicles, pedestrians, horse riders, horses and non-event cyclists to safely facilitate the holding of the Dudley section of the Velo Birmingham & Midlands 2019, in the interests of both the event itself and public safety.

DUDLEY METROPOLITAN BOROUGH COUNCIL

(VELO BIRMINGHAM & MIDLANDS) (TRAFFIC REGULATION) (SPECIAL EVENT) ORDER 2019

WHEREAS the Dudley Metropolitan Borough Council (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") being the Highway Authority for Dudley is satisfied that vehicular, pedestrians, horse riders, horses and non-event cyclist traffic should be prohibited and restricted on the roads specified in the Schedules attached hereto to facilitate the holding of the event.

NOW THEREFORE the Council in exercise of its powers under S.16A of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended by Section 1 of the Road Traffic (Special Events) Act 1994 (hereinafter referred to as "the Act") and all other enabling powers and with the consent of the English Government hereby make the following Order prohibiting and restricting the use of certain roads and road junctions by vehicles, pedestrians, horse riders, horses and non-event cyclists to facilitate the holding of the Velo Birmingham & Midlands 2019 on Sunday 12th May 2019.

The Order shall come into operation on 12th May 2019 and may be cited as the Dudley Metropolitan Borough Council (Velo Birmingham & Midlands) (Traffic Regulation) (Special Event) Order 2019.

In this Order, the following expressions have the meanings hereby respectively assigned to them:-

"Relevant Event" means the Velo Birmingham & Midlands 2019.

"Council" means Dudley Metropolitan Borough Council.

"Act" means the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended by Section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1994.

"Designated Officer" means an Officer appointed by the Council in respect of traffic management of the Birmingham Velo 2017.

"Motor Vehicle" means a mechanically propelled vehicle intended or adapted for use on roads as set out in Section 136 (1) of the Act.

"Motor Cycle" means a mechanically propelled vehicle, as defined in Section 185 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1988.

"Police Vehicle" has the same meaning as in the TSRGD.

"Bus" has the same meaning as in Schedule 1 of Regulation 2 of the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016 (SI 2016.362) – TSRGD.

"Public Service Vehicle" means a vehicle as defined in Section 1 of the Public Passenger Vehicles Act 1981.

"Disabled Person's Parking Badge" means a badge issued in accordance with the Disabled Persons (Badges for Motor Vehicles) (ENGLAND) (Regulations 2000 as amended) or a similar badge issued by another country within the European Unions.

"Universal Service Provider" has the same meaning as that assigned to it in Section 4 (3) of the Postal Services Act 2000.

- No person shall cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed along the lengths of road specified in Schedules to this Order or any parts thereof (including junctions linking the said roads unless otherwise indicated) between the hours specified in the Schedules to the Order on Sunday 12th May 2019.
- 2. Any vehicle deemed to be hindering the passage of the race, causing a nuisance and / or obstruction on the roads; or road junctions specified in the Schedules to this Order shall be authorised by the Council to be removed.
- 3. Nothing in Article 1 of this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed along the lengths of road to which those Articles apply if it is necessary to do so to enable:
 - i. any vehicle being used in connection with the relevant event including those used for stewarding, crowd management and traffic management purposes or
- ii. any vehicle officially accredited to the relevant event and which displays the appropriate accreditation operating in connection with the relevant event, or
- iii. any vehicle being used on the direction of or with the permission of a police constable in uniform or a traffic marshal, designated officer or any other official so authorised in the control and operation of the relevant event or in accordance with any sign placed by the Council or approved traffic management specialist acting on behalf of the event organiser, or
- iv. any vehicle being used in connection with the relevant event by a designated officer.
- v. any vehicle being used for the removal of any vehicle deemed to be hindering the passage of the race, causing a nuisance and / or obstruction on the roads or road junctions, specified in the Schedules to this Order, or
- vi. the vehicle to be used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes in cases of emergency, or
- vii. the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in pursuance of statutory powers or duties or in connection with any building operation or demolition, the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the road or the laying, erection, alteration or repair in, or in land adjacent to the road of any sewer or of any main, pipe, wire or cable or any apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of any electronic communications apparatus as defined in Schedule 2 to the Telecommunications Act 1984.
- 4. Save as provided in Article 3, except upon the direction of or with the permission of a Police Constable, Police Community Support Officer, designated officer, event organiser or any person in connection with the relevant event, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle or bus to stop or wait, including waiting for the purpose of loading and unloading goods in the lengths of road or on any verges specified in the Schedules to this Order during the hours specified in the Schedule to this Order on Sunday 12th May 2019.

- 5. Save as provided in Article 3, except upon the direction of or with the permission of a Police Constable, Police Community Support Officer, designated officer, event organiser or any person in connection with the relevant event, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle or bus to stop or wait to enable a person to board or alight from a vehicle in the lengths of road or on any verges specified in the Schedules to this Order during the hours specified in this Order on Sunday 12th May 2019.
- 6. Save as provided in Article 3, except upon the direction of or with the permission of a Police Constable, Police Community Support Officer, designated officer, event organiser or any person in connection with the relevant event, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle being used by a Universal Service Provider to enter or proceed, stop or wait in the lengths of road or on any verges specified in the Schedules to this Order during the hours specified in this Order on Sunday 12th September 2019.

7. TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF STOPPING

Save as provided in Article 3, except upon the direction of or with the permission of a Police Constable, Police Community Support Officer, designated officer, event organiser or any person in connection with the relevant event, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to stop or remain at rest in the lengths of road or on any verges specified in Schedule 2 to this Order during the hours of 8:15am and 7:00pm on Sunday 12th May 2019.

8. TEMPORARY SUSPENSION OF EXISTING DISABLED PERSONS PARKING PLACES (DPPP'S)

Save as provided in Article 3, except upon the direction of or with the permission of a Police Constable, Police Community Support Officer, designated officer, event organiser or any person in connection with the relevant event, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle being used for the conveyance of a disabled person and has displayed in a conspicuous position a disabled persons badge to wait on the roads or sides of roads or an any verges specified in the Schedules to this Order during the hours of 8:15am and 7:00pm on Sunday 12th May 2019.

- 9. Save as provided in Article 3, except upon the direction of or with the permission of a Police Constable, Police Community Support Officer, designated officer, event organiser or any person in connection with the relevant event, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle being used for the conveyance of a disabled person and has displayed in a conspicuous position a disabled persons badge to park within a parking bay marked as only available for a disabled persons vehicle on any of the roads identified in the Schedules to this Order during the hours specified in the Schedules to this Order on Sunday 12th May 2019.
- 10. Except upon the direction of a Police Constable, Police Community Support Officer, designated officer, event organiser or any person in connection with the relevant event, no exemptions will apply for disabled persons vehicles on any of the roads specified in the Schedules to this Order during the hours specified in the Schedules to this Order for the duration of the Order.
- 11. Save as provided in Article 3, except upon the direction of or with the permission of a Police Constable, Police Community Support Officer, designated officer, event organiser or any person in connection with the relevant event, no person shall cause or permit any mechanically propelled vehicles or horse drawn vehicles intended for use on or off roads, or any person riding, leading or driving horses or any other animals to proceed in the lengths of road or on any verges specified in the

- Schedules to this Order during the hours of 8:15am and 7:00pm on Sunday 12th May 2019.
- 12. The Interpretation Act 1889 shall apply to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
- 13. The Council are satisfied that, in order to avoid danger to persons or other traffic using the roads to which this Order relates, or for preventing the likelihood of any such danger arising, or for facilitating the passage of the vehicular traffic on the roads, vehicular access to premises situated in the Schedules to this Order or accessible only therefrom may be restricted for the duration of the Order save as provided in Article 3 of this Order.
- 14. The Council are also satisfied, in accordance with Section 16A (3) of the Act, that the event to which this Order relates cannot be held otherwise than on a road. Such is the length of the route and the nature of the closure, the Council does not consider it practical to recommend alternative routes for traffic.
- 15. Access for pedestrians to premises situated on or adjacent to any road to which the Order relates will not be prevented.

Any vehicle deemed to be hindering the passage of the race, causing a nuisance and/or obstruction on the roads, road junctions or verges specified in the Schedules to the Order shall be authorised by the Council to be removed.
