firstly Ruth, thank you for setting things out in connection with the meeting that we are having with St Albans on 30th Nov.

As we discussed yesterday afternoon, (when I set out the timetable associated with the work which has been carried out on Primary School place planning), I suspect that will not want us to talk explicitly about the recommended permutation of school expansions contained in her business justification papers, as these will not have been considered by the Education Panel unitl 16th December.

I would certainly anticipate that it is unlikely that is going to want or accept release of extracts of business justification papers in advance of that being cleared with the appropriate politicians/panels here - but that is something which we would need to discuss further at a meeting between us, in advance of meeting SADC.

Our planning appraisals of the existing school sites are nearly completed now.
