RE: FREEDOM OF INFORMATION REQUEST

Thank you for your e-mail of 28th November 2013 requesting details on the Department of Energy and Climate Change (DECC) officials' overseas travel expenditure.

Specifically you asked -

- i. the number of staff who had visited the US and Canada for work related business in the calendar years of 2011, 2012 and to date in 2013;
- ii. the names of airlines and what class of flight was taken on each trip;
- iii. the names of hotels used and
- iv. if the Department ever approved for any staff member to use VIP facilities at any UK or international airport for work related business.

You also asked that the information be broken-down to show the costs of each trip detailing

- v. flights,
- vi. accommodation,
- vii. transport and other costs such as
 - o internet, faxes and 'phone-calls.

Additionally you asked to provide information where staff members

- viii. were unable to provide a vouched receipt to claim work related costs and the reason why;
- ix. the amount refunded in each case.

We are able to answer some but not all of the questions you have asked.

Our records are ordered in financial years (April 2011 to March 2012, April 2012 to March 2013 and April 2013 to September 2013) - the breakdown of available information relating to flights and hotels used in the US and Canada is annexed at "A" and "B" to this e-mail. Please note that the analysis for 2011-12 is not complete as we do not hold a full analysis of the hotel spend by location for the period April to September.

We do not hold centrally any records of instances of staff being permitted to use VIP facilities at any UK or international.

Regarding information where staff were unable to provide receipts - once a claim has been approved, the Department's financial accounting system doesn't keep a record of whether receipts were provided. To obtain this information would necessitate a manual review of all claims which we estimate would exceed the FOI cost limit as described below.

Whilst I can confirm that it is likely that the Department does hold information on the number of staff who have visited US and Canada and incurred incidental expenses including internet, faxes and telephone-calls again it is not possible to provide this information to you without exceeding the cost limit of £600 provided under Section 12 of the Freedom of Information Act. This represents the estimated cost of spending 3.5 working days spent (i) determining whether the Department holds the information, and (ii) locating, retrieving and extracting the information and diverting scarce staff resources from more important tasks.

The Act provides that we are not obliged to comply with requests where the estimated cost of complying would exceed this limit.

It is not possible, for the reasons described above, to provide information on other transport costs incurred by DECC staff visiting the US and Canada particularly where travel (including taxis) or hotels have not been booked through DECC's contracted travel management companies and for good reason as such expenses will be subsumed in a more general "subsistence/other" category. You may wish to consider how the scope of your request could be narrowed to bring it within the cost limit.

You may be interested to know that the Department's travel policy updated on October 2010 provides that:

- staff should only travel if it is absolutely necessary
- subsistence claims must be based on actual costs
- all travel bookings must be made through the official suppliers
- standard or economy class must be used unless there is a clear business need for a higher class to be approved
- all expense claims will need to be approved regardless of grade
- such expense claims must be accompanied by the relevant supporting documents - unless receipts were not provided, for example when using an Oyster card. In such instances, a written explanation for any lack of receipts (or for any unusual expenditure) in support of expense claims must be provided to SSCL.

Appeal Procedure

If you are dissatisfied with the handling of your request, you have the right to ask for an internal review. Internal review requests should be submitted within two months of the date of receipt of the response to your original letter and should be addressed to the Information Rights Unit at:
