We are content to defer (but not waiver) clawback for **Waddesdon** children's centre, as the funding for the asset will continue to be used for purposes consistent with the grant (predominately early years calculated at 55%). However we retain our interest in the asset and due to its usage being at the limit of what we regard as 'predominately early years use', your authority must inform the department if in the future the early years usage that has been declared changes. Also if the asset is transferred or otherwise disposed of, and does not continue to meet the purposes of the grant the local authority must inform us and we will consider clawback of the funding.
