Release of Information

Thank you for your email of 23 November 2014 requesting the following information:

I would like to receive the information on water boats, radars and systems, used by MOD for prevention of illegal immigration, drug smuggling and possible terrorism acts

Your enquiry has been considered to be a request for information in accordance with the Freedom of Information Act 2000.

The Ministry of Defence does not hold the information specified in your request. The RN has no boats dedicated to the tasks outlined in your request. Instead Ships have a general purpose 24ft inflatable craft, primarily used for Safety Of Life/Man overboard recovery at sea. These are not fitted with a radar.

The activities you have requested information on are the responsibility of another Government Department, the Home Office, who you might contact for any information they can provide. Freedom of Information requests on this subject can be made via the following email link

Please note that the Information Commissioner will not investigate your case until the MOD internal review process has been completed.
