Mental Health Law

- Mental health law is made up of the following:
- Statute (laws made by Parliament):
- Mental Health Act 1983
- Mental Capacity Act 2005
- Human Rights Act 1998
- Regulations: Secondary Legislation. They tell us how to enact the statute.
- <u>Case Law</u>: Judges interpret the law and their judgements direct how we enact it.
- Statutory Guidance: Mental Health Act Code of Practice and The Mental Health Act Guide.

- S12 Doctor.
- A.C. Approved Clinician
- R.C. Responsible Clinician
- Nearest Relative (NR).
