**Re: Freedom of Information request**

Thank you for your recent request to Bedfordshire PCT under the Freedom of Information Act. Please see the Trust's replies, set out against your questions, below.

1) *How much money has been spent in the last five years on the hosting, development, content and design of your organisation's website? Please include costs of relevant staff wages as well as any external suppliers.*

2) *What is the value of the organisation's website in your current asset register?*

3) *What will happen to the website when the organisation is closed down under the Health and Social Care Act?*

The website will be closed down. Although Bedfordshire PCT still exists, it is already operating in a cluster as NHS Bedfordshire and Luton and much of the information on the website will be transferred to the new websites of Bedfordshire Clinical Commissioning Group (BCCG) and Luton Clinical Commissioning Group LCCG).

4) *How will the answer to 3) be accounted for in your capital accounts?*

This information is not held: formal guidance has yet to be received in relation to asset registers.
