Dear Ariyan Hoque,

Your request was received on 25 March 2021 and I am dealing with it under the terms of the Freedom of Information Act 2000 ('the Act'). You asked:

Could you please provide any data stored for the A100 Medicine course:

- 1) If each section of the BMAT is weighted equally
- 2) The percentage weighting of the BMAT score (if any) and how it is used
- 3) How GCSEs are weighted in the application process
- 4) Percentage weightings for any and all parameters used for selection
