## **RE: YOUR REQUEST FOR INFORMATION:**

I am writing further to your request for information dated 8 January 2019. We have now completed our search for the information you requested. This information is being provided as a statutory obligation under the Freedom of Information Act 2000.

## Your request:

Has the council ever entered into a contract or grant agreement for the following:

- a) provision of behavioural intervention programmes, or programmes designed to reduce violence or improve emotional and social wellbeing of young people?
- b) provision of training to staff working with young people to build understanding of trauma?

If yes, could you please provide the following details:

- a) supplier/grant recipient name
- b) how referrals are generated e.g. through schools or community partners
- c) which schools/community partners are/were used
- d) length and value of agreement
- e) monitoring and evaluation metrics used to measure impact

## **Our Response:**
