Dear Sir/Madam,

Thank you for your e-mail of 26 August about compliance certification of electronic door entry systems. I have been asked to reply and apologise for the long delay in doing so.

No planning permission would be needed in respect of electronic door systems. However, it is likely that the work in installing such a system would have been work controlled under the Building Regulations 2010. In this case there should be either a competent person scheme compliance certificate or a local authority completion certificate to say that the work complied with the Building Regulations. Your local authority would know whether such a certificate had been issued.
