Hi All – if you have time could you provide with a short paragraph about any commissioned service or work you are doing/aware of with voluntary sector / community groups that will help bridge the divide between east and west Merton in terms of inequalities? Unfortunately needs it today for a report to CMT
– this is from some of the projects I am working on – hope you can use/ helpful
We know that nationally people in more deprived areas do less physical activity than people in more deprived areas. Public Health commissioned to carry out research on physical activity and older people and deliver a number of active ageing pilot projects. As part of the research analysed results by 'east' and 'west' Merton and included focus groups comprised of residents in both areas. Following the research a number of pilots took place including exercise classes at

Mitcham. A walking football daytime pilot (aimed at men over 50 but open to all) at the Canons Leisure Centre was also developed with working in partnership with GLL leisure and AFC Wimbledon. The pilot has been a success with Canons now continuing the daytime offer at the Canons centre. We know the east of the Borough has a higher Black and Minority Ethnic population in Merton. Public Health commission a befriending service for older people run by A As part of this contract targets include a number of BME community groups to engage per year and targets for the number of BME volunteer befrienders and BME clients. Merton's Dementia Action Alliance comprises a range of partners (Merton Council, Merton CCG, statutory sector and community / voluntary groups and businesses) all aimed at making Merton a dementia friendly community. One of the key aims for 2019/20 has been a focus on engaging BME communities around dementia and our is working with bme organisations and faith groups in the Borough. Officers have also raised awareness on dementia and joining the Alliance at Merton's BAME and Faith Forums. We know that lower income men from more deprived areas are at higher risk of suicide than those in more affluent areas. We also know higher rates of mental health problems are associated with poverty and socio-economic disadvantage. Public Health have funded a number of Mental Health First Aid and Suicide Awareness training courses aimed at the community and voluntary sector as well as statutory partners. Locations for these have and the Wilson included hospital.
