## Freedom of Information Act 2000 – Request for Information

Thank you for your request received by Yorkshire Ambulance Service NHS Trust (YAS) on 18 May 2016. Please find our responses below.

## Your request

- Considering your rota pattern for frontline emergency staff (those who are responsible for responding to 999 calls, for example paramedics, technicians, ECAs etc.), what was the total number of pre-planned working hours for April 2016 in your Trust?
- 2. How many pre-planned standard working hours were actually covered by frontline emergency staff in April 2016?
- 3. How many pre-planned standard working hours were covered by frontline emergency staff on voluntary overtime (ie. pre-booked an overtime shift) in April 2016?
- 4. How many pre-planned standard working hours were covered by private ambulance service staff in April 2016?
- 5. How many additional hours were covered by frontline emergency staff on enforced overtime (ie. end of shift overtime) in April 2016?
- 6. How many instances occurred where frontline staff (as individuals) did not receive a rest beak during their shift in April 2016?
- 7. How many instances occurred where frontline staff (as individuals) did receive a rest break during a shift but it was not complaint with the definition of a rest break (as defined in the European Working Team Directive) in April 2016?

## Trust response

We can confirm that we hold the data requested.

- 1. In April 2016 there were 276,221 pre-planned working hours for responding to 999 calls.
- 2. In April 2016 there were 273,883 pre-planned working hours covered by frontline emergency staff.
- 3. In April 2016 there were 33,681 pre-planned working hours which were covered by voluntary overtime.
- 4. In April 2016 there were 12,960 pre-planned working hours that were covered by private ambulances.

- 5. In April 2016 there were 7,600 hours in end of shift overtime.
