We refer to your request where you asked:

"1. A transcript of the speech you and Mr Vallance made on 10 February 2021 re the Pcr test and the rapid response tests as after listening to it three times i found it totally incomprehensible but what millions of UK people did hear Mr Vallance say was and I quote: PCR are very very sensitive, they can pick up very low levels of virus which may not even be infectious!"
