Thank you for your request for information dated 18/12/2019 about Zebra Crossings. We have dealt with this under the Environmental Information Regulations 2004.

## Response

The council holds the information requested and the answers to your questions are as follows:

I am looking to find out the locations of Zebra crossings in Camden Borough Council. Please can you provide me with the following information:

- 1) A list of all the pedestrian zebra crossings within Camden Borough Council boundaries. Attached is a CSV of our Zebra Crossings.
- 2) Information on how many Belisha beacons on each crossing point.

Attached is a CSV of all our Belisha Beacons in the borough with coordinate information. This means that when exported into a GIS software with the Zebra Crossing data you will be able to view the number of Belisha Beacons at any given site.

3) The above would ideally include the use of the Geo-coordinate system information of each site, but also the street name and location.

Included in both datasets.
