Thank you for your request for information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000.

Further to my acknowledgement I confirm that the Trust holds the information requested and is able to release it as follows.

Whether the Trust employs anyone under zero-hours contracts (including via private contractors if the information is available)

The Trust does have its own Bank Administration staff on zero hour contracts. There are, I believe, no other zero hour contracts in place.

If so, the number of such contracts and a summary of the roles they cover.

The current amount of Bank staff is 63 and we therefore have 63 individual contracts in place, one per person. All these staff are Bank Administration and the work they do includes secretarial cover for both clinical and non-clinical areas. They also provide staffing for our in-house record stores.
